

## **Olney Pediatrics Vaccine Schedule**

Below is the current vaccine schedule for well visits at Olney Pediatrics.

**Newborn:** Hepatitis B # 1 (if not given in the hospital)

**1 month:** Hepatitis B # 2

**2 months:** Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Prevnar (pneumococcal), and Rotavirus (oral)

**4 months:** Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Prevnar (pneumococcal), and Rotavirus (oral)

**6 months:** Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Prevnar (pneumococcal), and Rotavirus (oral), Flu

**9 months:** Hepatitis B #3

**12 months:** MMR, Varicella, Prevnar

**15 months:** Pentacel (Dtap, IPV, HIB), Hepatitis A #1

**24 months:** Hepatitis A #2

**4 yo:** Proquad (MMR, Varicella), Kinrix (Dtap, IPV)

**9-10yo:** HPV # 1 (2-3 shot series\*)

**11 yo:** Tdap, Meningococcal A #1, HPV

**16 yo:** Meningococcal A #2

Meningococcal B (2 shot series)

- Prior to college (16-18yo) or for high risk patients

\*HPV (Human Papilloma Virus):

- For persons initiating vaccination before age 15, the recommended immunization schedule is 2 doses of HPV vaccine at 0 and 6-12 months.
- For persons initiating vaccination at age 15 years or older, the recommended immunization schedule is 3 doses of HPV vaccine at 0, 1–2 months, and 6 months.

\*\* Influenza: recommended to all children older than 6 months.

- 2 doses (separated by at least 4 weeks) to children who are receiving influenza vaccine for the first time or who have not previously received  $\geq 2$  doses of the influenza vaccine before July 1, 2016.

**Please Note:** Occasionally, due to vaccine shortages and changes in product availability from different manufacturers, vaccine schedules may have to be altered. We will inform you if changes are being made to ensure your child remains up to date.
